



Tips for teaching the come command

- As a rule, whenever the dog comes to you or the owner, immediate praise follows
- Start off leashing the dog so you can coax the dog towards you with the command and guidance of the leash
- Getting in motion and creating separation encourages the dog to follow you, thus allowing you to mark a successful come command.
- Do not mark the come behavior until the dog actually gets to you
- If the dog stops or gets distracted, guide her to you with the leash
- Always mark the come command positively.
- Coming to a person should always be **POSITIVE!!**
- **NEVER, EVER** call a dog to you for the purpose of correction!
- **Why would a dog go to someone who is going to correct them!**
